

Dear RAG Supporters

Just to update you on the penultimate Twickenham Riverside development consultation that is to be held in the **Clarendon Hall, York House Gardens, Richmond Road, Twickenham TW1 3BZ.**

The consultation takes place on the following dates:

- **Monday 9 October from 6 to 8.30pm**
- **Thursday 12 October from 6 to 8.30pm**
- **Saturday 14 October from 11am to 4pm**
- **Monday 16 October from 6 to 8.30pm**
- **Thursday 26 October from 6 to 8.30pm.**

We urge you to go, look and ask questions.

Discover for yourself if the Council has listened to the overwhelming public call for an open vista to the river from King Street, a village square, public space for gatherings, and pedestrian connectivity from Water Lane through to both the river and the Diamond Jubilee Gardens.

Decide if the original Romanesque design of two years ago has been truly abandoned and replaced with appropriate architectural styles that complement Twickenham's village streets, cafés and riverside units as well as the homes that already exist along our working waterfront.

Be sure that maintenance of the proposed development is not a drain on our Council tax resources, and the freehold of the land is retained by our community.

RAG continues to work with the other main stakeholders in Twickenham, as we have for the past eighteen months. We consider the approach of our groups working together – critically but constructively – with the Council's officers, to have borne fruit. We continue to hope the outcome will serve the long term needs of all residents and businesses, and will be attractive, practical and non-political.

We will let you have our thoughts on the Council's plans and we will, as always, be grateful for your suggestions many of which we have already fed through in our meetings with the Council's technical team.
